




Disassembly Instructions

Step 1: Remove the hand clamp

Remove the six M3 screws (thread length 10mm) on the side of the hand, and take out the clamp, as shown in the following figure.




Step 2: Remove the prosthetic hand





Put in the clamp and tighten the six M3 screws (thread length 10mm), as shown in the following figure.




Step 1: Remove the cover plate

Remove the two M2 screws (thread length 5mm) and take out the cover plate, as shown in the following figure.




Step 2: Remove the clamp

Remove the two M3 screws (thread length 10mm), and take out the clamp (note to protect the cable), as shown in the following figure.




Step 3: Remove the prosthetic hand


Step 1: Install the prosthetic hand

Put in the prosthetic hand (note to distinguish between the left and right prosthetic hands and the placement direction), as shown in the following figure.




Step 2: Install the hand clamp

Put in the clamp (note to protect the cable) and tighten the two M3 screws (thread length 10mm), as shown in the following figure.



Step 3: Install the cover plate

Put in the cover plate (note to protect the cable) and tighten the two M2 screws (thread length 5mm), as shown in the following figure.
